Building Resilience

- Prepare an emergency kit with essentials

- Know your neighbours and build a support network
- Practice evacuation drills and first aid

Household Emergency Plan

- Create a plan for evacuation and communication
- Ensure family knows emergency meeting points
- Discuss how to protect pets and property

Emergency Contacts

- Call **000** for **Police, Fire, or Ambulance**
- For storm, flood, and rescue assistance call **SES** on **132 500**
- Save local council and alert sites
- Keep a list of contacts in your kit


Stay Informed

- Download emergency apps and sign up for alerts
- Follow local emergency services on social media
- Keep up-to-date with weather forecasts and warnings


Aid and Recovery

- Access local community support programs
- Utilise available mental health resources
- Focus on rebuilding homes and supporting local businesses
