

Bushfire Safety Checklist for Australians



Understanding Ember Attacks

Ember attacks occur when burning embers are carried by the wind, creating new fire spots away from the main blaze. Use this checklist to improve your bushfire defense:

- Know local bushfire risk and ember behavior patterns
- Remove dry leaves, bark, and other debris from gutters
- Seal gaps around windows, doors, and the roof
- Clear flammable vegetation and materials around your home
- Store flammable items like wood piles and fuel safely
- Install metal gutter guards and ember-resistant vents
- Have a bushfire survival plan and an emergency kit ready
- Know your local evacuation routes and meeting points
